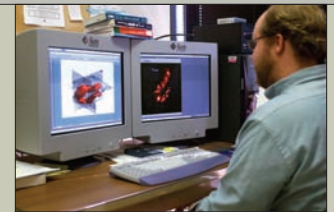
Student Housing and Support
